

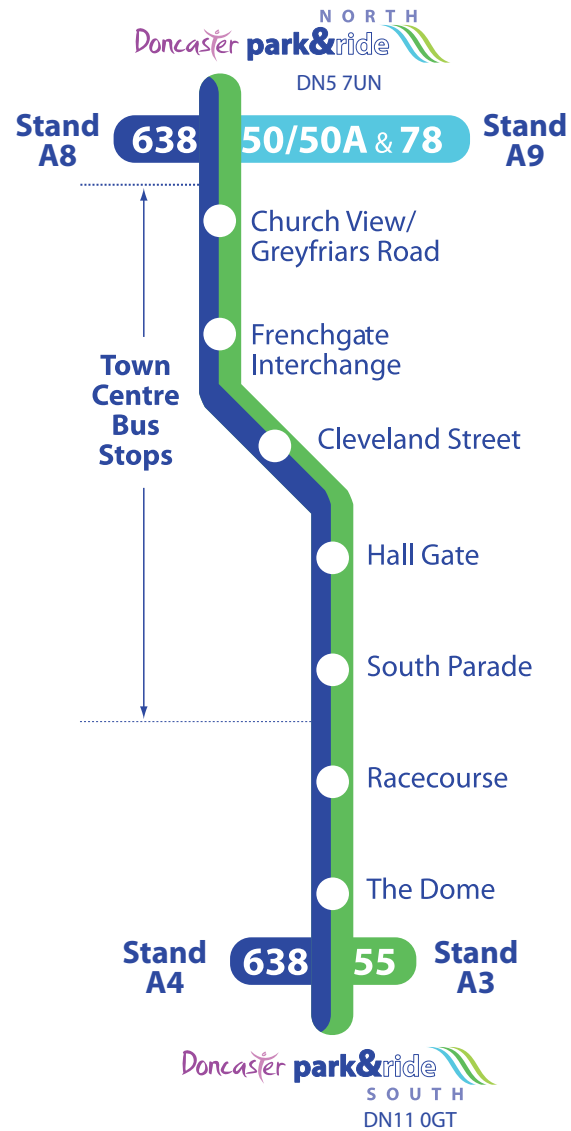
Providing the best Park & Ride facilities in Doncaster

Opened in 2008, the A638 Park & Ride facilities are the direct result of working partnerships between commercial providers and government organisations.

Integral to the appeal of the A638 service are the bus priority measures operating throughout the route, offering considerably reduced journey times and a fast, efficient and reliable bus service. This Park & Ride scheme is part of a wider development to provide people who live and work in Doncaster with practical and affordable transport choices. With one of the country's most successful and modern transport interchanges at Frenchgate in the heart of the town, Doncaster is leading the way for key developments in public transport. What is Park & Ride?

Doncaster Park & Ride gives you the best of both worlds:

- Allowing those who need to use the car the chance to leave it in a secure location and link to public transport - both into Doncaster and beyond.
- Avoiding the stresses and strains of urban traffic congestion.
- Helping to sustain the environment by using public transport and reducing carbon emissions.

Doncaster Park & Ride also provides:

- 638 service buses which are Euro 5 emission standard compliant.
- Direct links with fast, frequent local bus services.

- Comfortable, indoor waiting areas - featuring RealTime passenger information screens with the latest departure times.

What will it cost me?

Parking at either of the Park & Ride sites is completely free of charge. Coupled with group, student and child ticket discounts and a maximum adult return fare of just £2.00 per day, Doncaster Park & Ride represents terrific value for money.

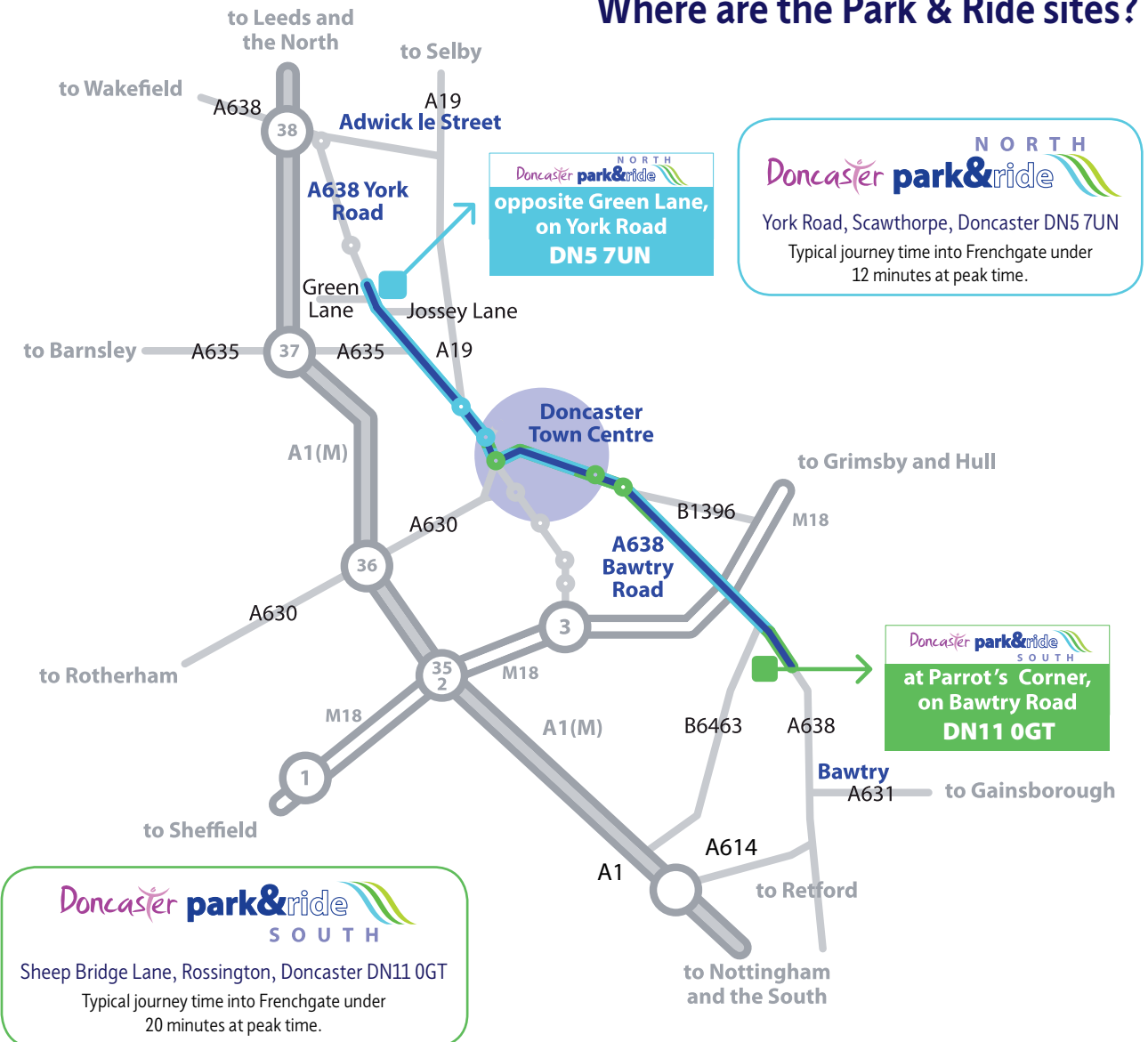
How to use

1. Enter car park through the barrier.
2. Purchase Park & Ride ticket from machine within the facilities building. Just one ticket entry is needed for all buses that call into the Park & Ride site.
3. Show the driver your tickets when you board the bus. From one of the town centre bus stops, use your return ticket to catch the bus back.
4. Use your ticket to open the barrier when you leave the car park.

Where are the Park & Ride sites?



Doncaster park&ride NORTH
York Road, Scawthorpe, Doncaster DN5 7UN
Typical journey time into Frenchgate under 12 minutes at peak time.

Opening Times 6 days a week, Monday to Saturday from 0700 to 1900.
The 638 is a dedicated service, running at peak times Monday to Friday from 0700 to 0920 and 1600 to 1820.
The 50/50A and 78 services call into the North site, and each run every 15 minutes Monday to Saturday daytime.
Overall, a bus is scheduled to depart from the site towards Doncaster Frenchgate every seven to ten minutes or better.
The 55 service calls into the South site, and runs up to every 10 minutes on Monday to Saturday daytime.
