How to use the Tram



Accessibility

All trams are easy access with level boarding, and feature audio and visual announcements. Trams have wheelchair spaces available near the doors, along with accessible priority seating. Assistance dogs are welcome on all services.



Boarding the Tram

Tram doors will open in-line with the tactile paving at the tram stop. Please stand clear of the doors if other passengers are leaving the tram. Press the round button on the doors when lit and the tone sounds.



While on-board

The conductor will check your pre-purchased ticket or travel pass, or you can buy a ticket using cash or contactless. Information about ticketing is shown below. All stops are by request, you must press the stop request button.



Leaving the Tram

As the tram approaches your destination, press one of the orange stop request buttons located throughout the tram. Doors do not open automatically. Press the round button at the side or on the doors when lit and the tone sounds.



Bicycles


