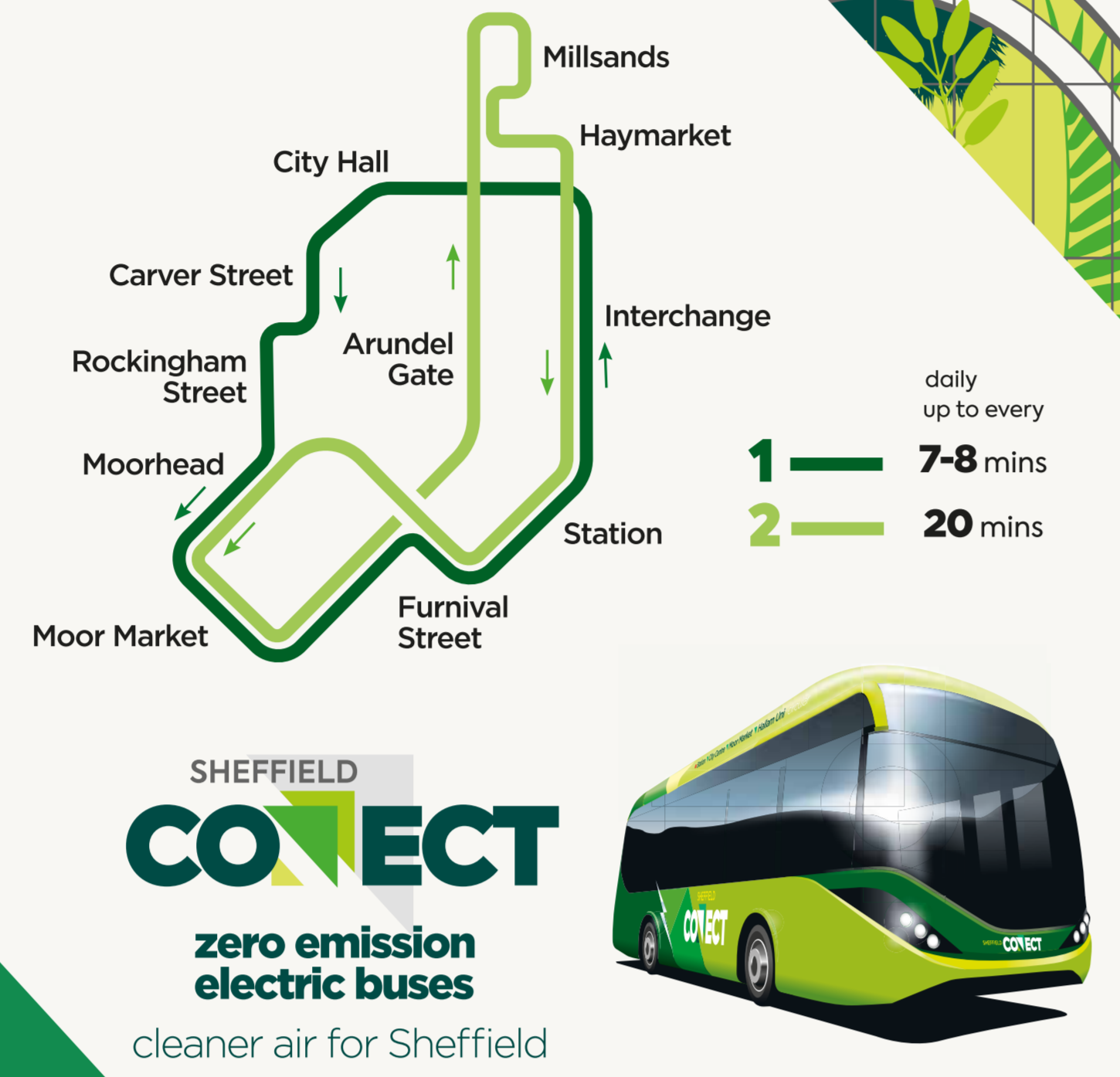

## How to use the Tram

**Accessibility**  
 All trams are easy access with level boarding, and feature audio and visual announcements. Trams have wheelchair spaces available near the doors, along with accessible priority seating. Assistance dogs are welcome on all services.

**Boarding the Tram**  
 Tram doors will open in-line with the tactile paving at the tram stop. Please stand clear of the doors if other passengers are leaving the tram. Press the round button on the doors when lit and the tone sounds.

**While on-board**  
 The conductor will check your pre-purchased ticket or travel pass, or you can buy a ticket using cash or contactless. Information about ticketing is shown below. **All stops are by request, you must press the stop request button.**

**Leaving the Tram**  
 As the tram approaches your destination, press one of the orange stop request buttons located throughout the tram. **Doors do not open automatically.** Press the round button at the side or on the doors when lit and the tone sounds.

**Bicycles**  
 You can park your bike for free at many Park and Ride sites, visit [travelsouthyorkshire.com/ParkAndRide](https://travelsouthyorkshire.com/ParkAndRide) for more information. **Bicycles are not permitted on the tram.** You are allowed to carry a folded bicycle (in its folded position).

All trams have conductors who can provide tickets and information. Contactless card and cash payments are accepted on-board.

Discounted prices are available for tickets purchased using the TSY Mobile app, TravelMaster app or website, or from a ticket vending machine at most Travel South Yorkshire interchanges.

Park your bike or car for free at a Travel South Yorkshire Park and Ride site, just pay for the cost of your travel!

A penalty fare system operates on-board Supertram. You must make every effort to tender your fare or valid pass or ticket to a member of staff. Failure to do so may result in a £10 penalty fare being charged.

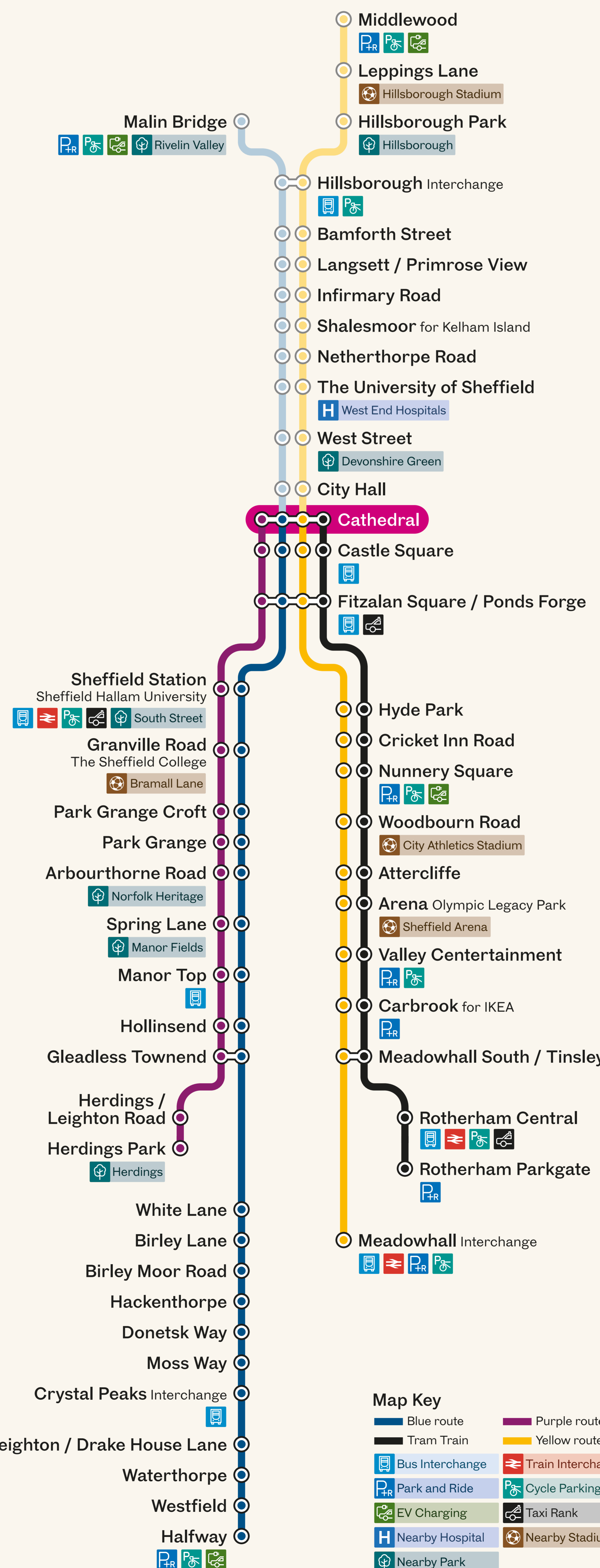
